The Ronald Reagan PTA is proud to announce the "**President's Volunteer Service Award Program**" for the new 2008-2009 school year.

We are teamed with the White House to become a Certifying Organization for the award, which recognizes Americans who have demonstrated a sustained commitment to volunteer service. ALL Ronald Reagan Rattlers are eligible and encouraged to participate. Even students that have never volunteered before are eligible to earn the President's Volunteer Service Award. Participation in a Reagan group, committee or club is not a requirement to participate in earning this Prestigious Award.

To earn this award, students must meet a minimum number of volunteer/service hours between May 1, 2008-April 30, 2009. There are three levels of the Award which are the Bronze, Silver and Gold. Each award recipient receives a personalized certificate of achievement, a congratulatory letter from the President of the United States and an official President's Award pin.
