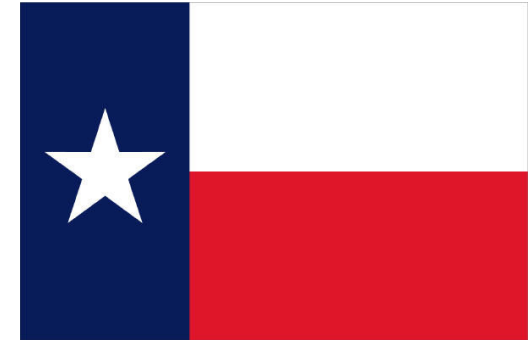

*Since 1909, the Texas PTA has made available the Honorary Texas PTA Life Membership Award as one of the highest honors that can be presented to individuals for outstanding service to children and youth.*

Life membership can be conferred by Local, Council, Area or State PTA's at any time of the year.

Presentations of Life Memberships are made to publicly recognize those people who have given of their time and ability in the interest of the young people of Texas.

Life Membership recipients are further recognized on a district wide level at the annual NEISD Founders' Day Banquet. The banquet will be held on February 12, 2009 at Red Oak Ballroom

In addition to the Honorary Texas PTA Life Membership Award, there are two more awards that can be given to outstanding volunteers, teachers or staff members.

### *Extended Service Award*

In 1987, the Texas PTA Board of Directors developed criteria for the awarding of an Extended Service Award to those people who have continued to give outstanding service to the Texas PTA. The recipients must have been actively involved in the Texas PTA for ten (10) years and have already been awarded the Honorary Texas PTA Life Membership Award.

### *National PTA Life Achievement Award*

Recipients of this award are usually those who have given outstanding service to children—someone who has promoted children's well-being by serving as an advocate for children in such areas as education, health, safety, and legislation. Honorees are people who care about children and have made their caring count by their devoted service to children and youth.

Examples of people who might receive this award are:

- ✓ A Senior citizen who volunteers in the school
- ✓ An outstanding teacher, perhaps one who is retiring this year
- ✓ A juvenile protection worker
- ✓ A legislator who has worked for laws that will benefit children and youth
